



1. Important Safety Instructions

- **cut&cap™** should only be used with utility type knives with disposable blades (also known as box cutter, carpet, Stanley knives etc.) Other knife types could damage the tool or cause injury. Always use new, sharp blades. (Utility knife not included.)
- Always cut away from your body and make sure that no one is standing directly in front of you.
- When using **cut&cap™** with the *Tool Holder* - hold the *Tool Holder* and not the sealant cartridge.
- When using the *Cutting Guide* without the *Tool Holder* - hold the sealant cartridge, place your thumb on the *Cutting Guide's* thumb profile and keep your fingers well below the *Cutting Guide*.
- This product can easily be adapted for left-handed use by relocating the *Cutting Guide* to the underside of the *Tool Holder* or by using the *Cutting Guide* independently of the *Tool Holder*. Refer to [3. Removing the Cutting Guide from the Cutting Guide](#) for more information.

2. Usage Instructions

- Remove the *Caps* from the disposable packaging piece and screw them onto the *Tool Holder* (please note that the packaging piece for the *Caps* is manufactured from 100% recyclable materials).
- **cut&cap™** is compatible with all standard C3, 290-310ml sealant cartridges (not Sika/Sikaflex or larger C4 cartridges – alternative models to suit these cartridge systems will be available soon).
- **Take care not to cross thread or overtighten the Cutting Guide whilst screwing it onto the sealant cartridge. Stop tightening as soon as you can feel that the bottom of the Cutting Guide has made contact with the top of the sealant cartridge.**
- The *Caps* will not seal properly unless the cartridge has been cut using the *Cutting Guide*.
- It may be necessary to remove the *Cutting Guide* from the *Tool Holder* for certain designs of cartridge or knife. Refer to [3. Removing the Cutting Guide from the Cutting Guide](#) for more information.
- Inexpensive replacement sealant cartridge nozzles can be purchased online or from all good hardware stores (avoid the resealable type because they are not air tight and are more expensive).
- The *Caps* are reusable but additional *Caps* can be purchased in packs of five or ten.

3. Removing the Cutting Guide from the Tool Holder

- To remove the *Cutting Guide*, undo the two hex screws on the reverse side of the *Tool Holder* using the included Hex Key and unclip the *Cutting Guide*. Reinstallation of the hex screws is optional – but if the screws are reinstalled then take care not to overtighten them.
- When using the *Cutting Guide* independently of the *Tool Holder*, it is recommended that you steady the *Cutting Guide* using your thumb on the thumb profile (refer to *Figure 2*). Do not use the thumb profile when the *Cutting Guide* is attached to the *Tool Holder*.

4. Further Information
